Our How: through language lessons, community events and campaigns



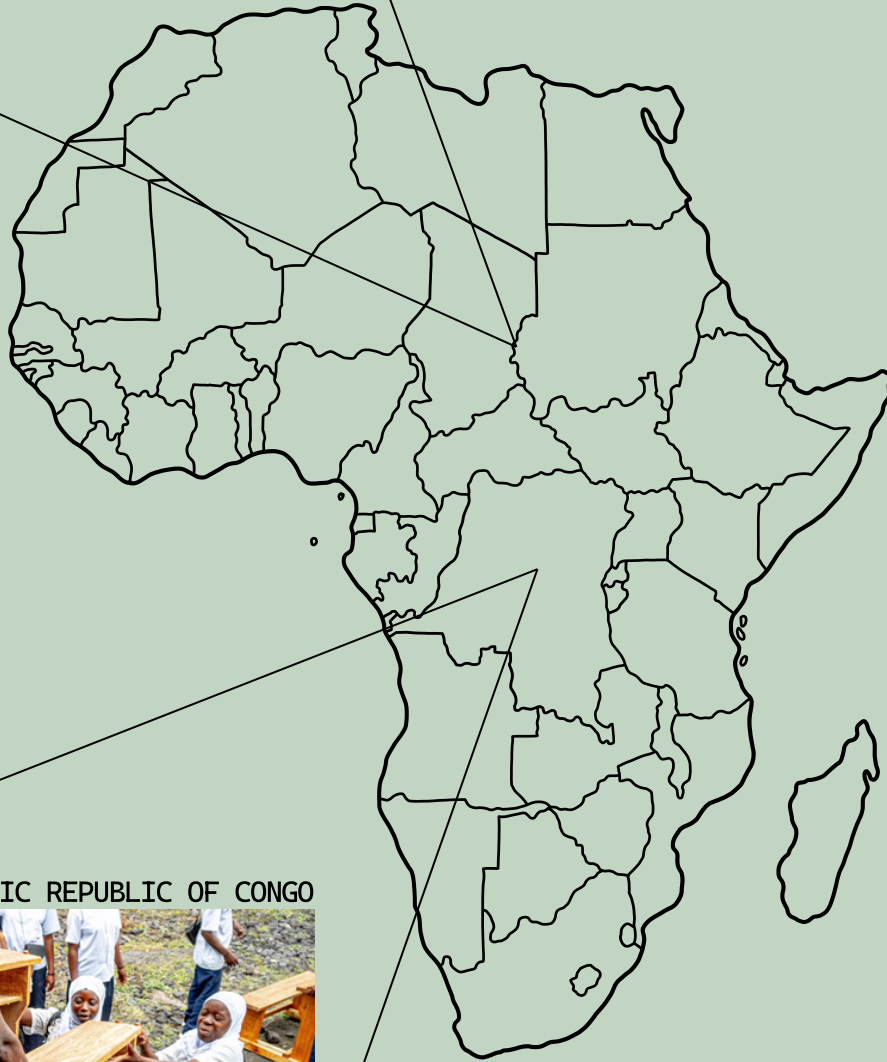
# OUR PARTNERS

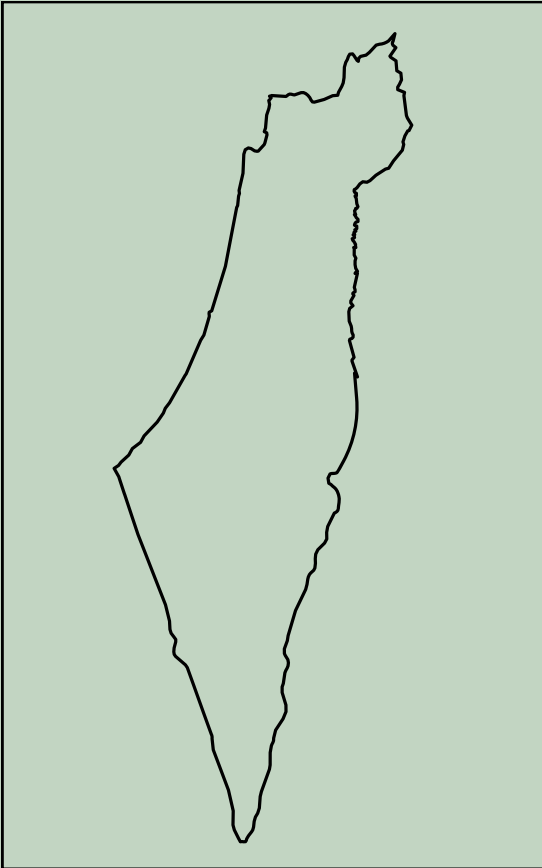

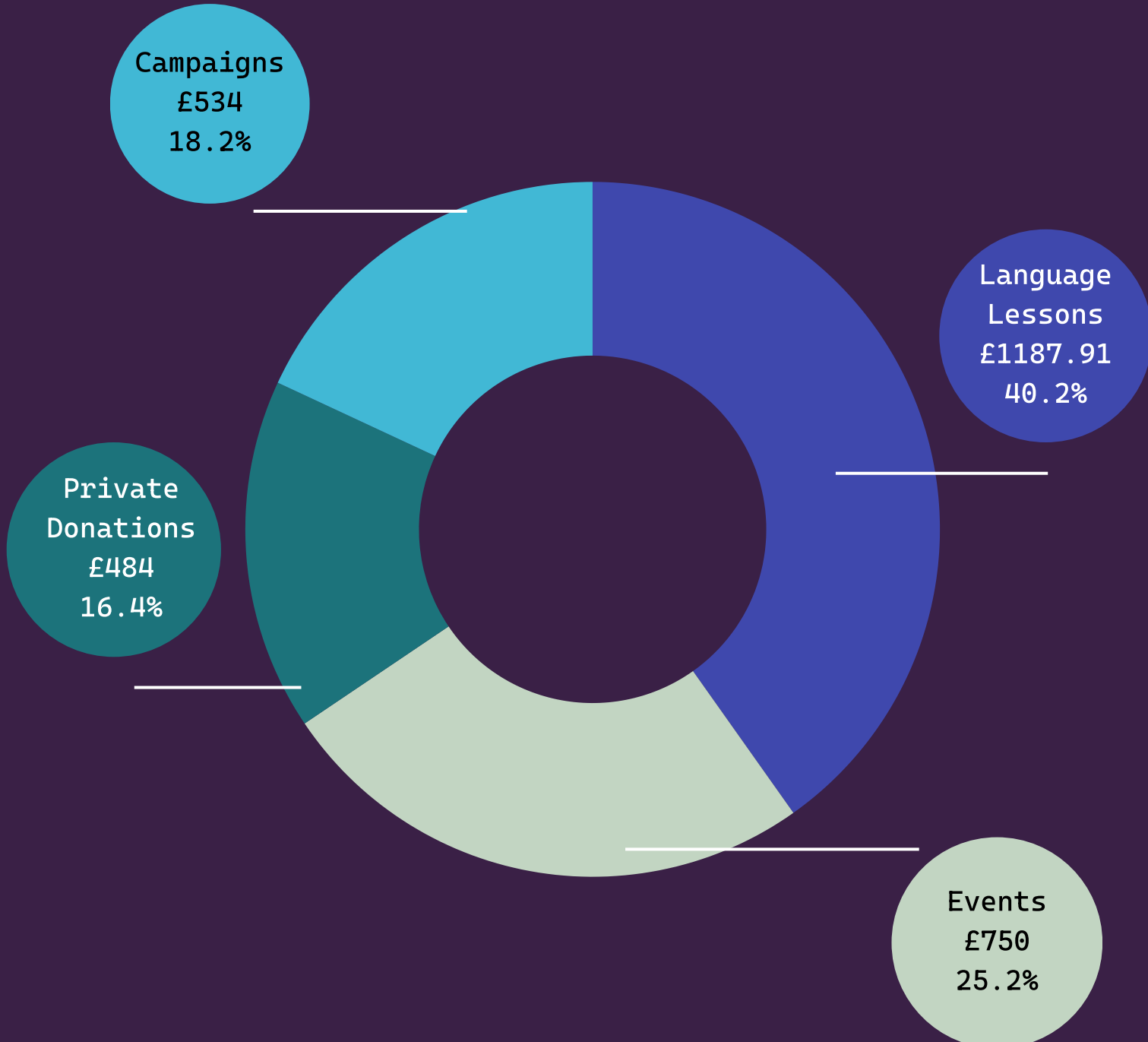

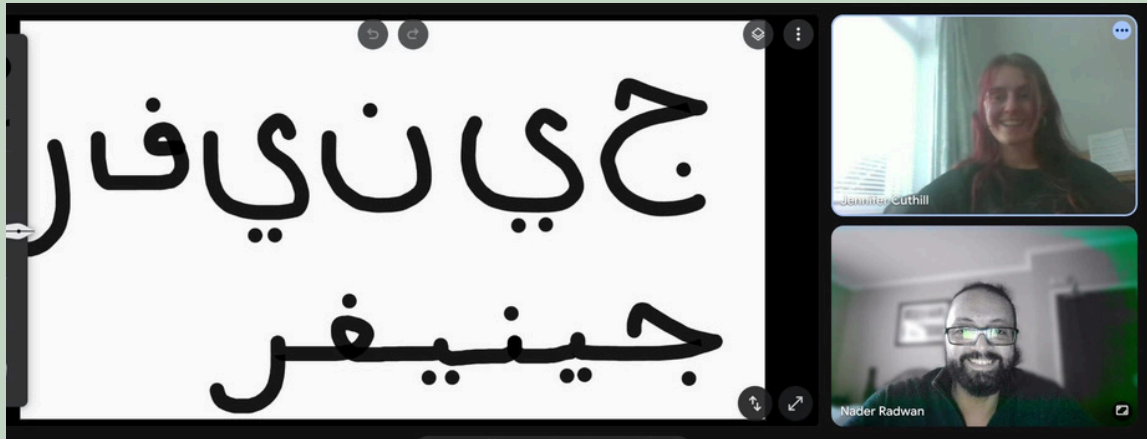
